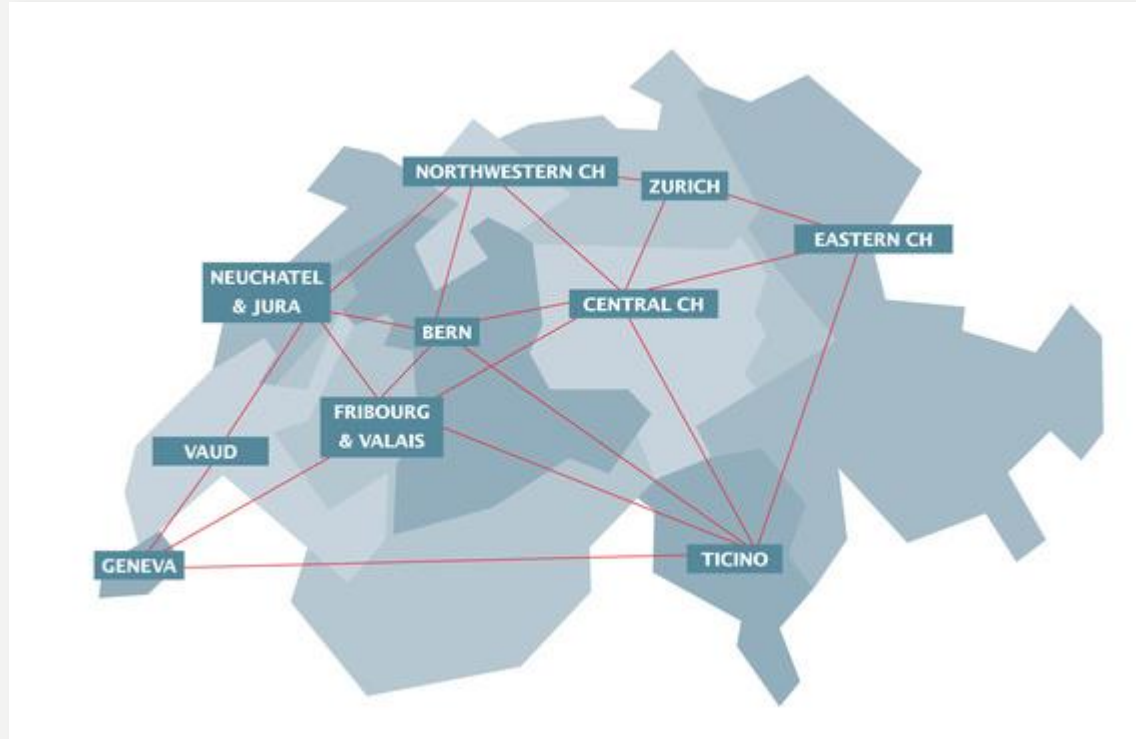

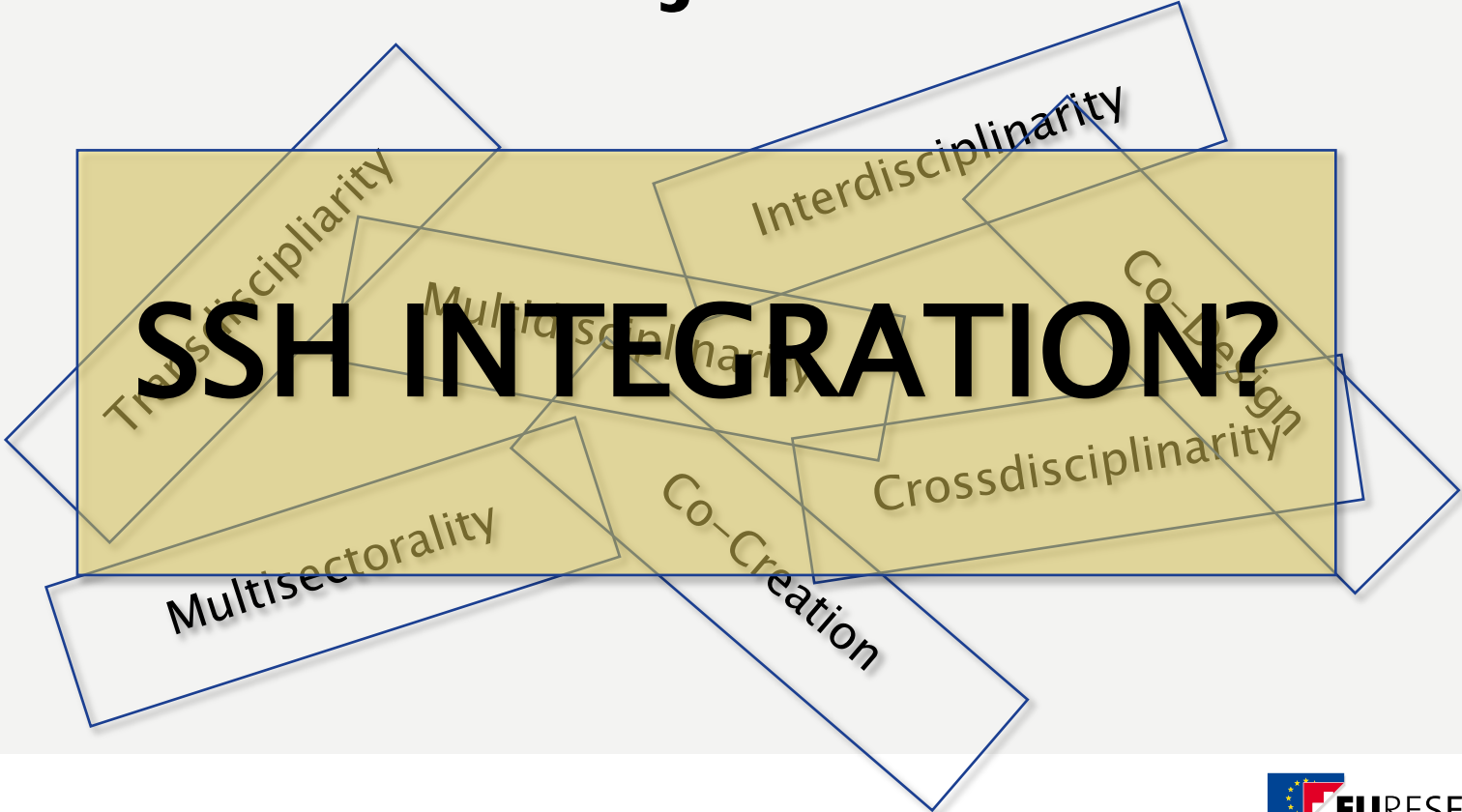


Goal of SSH Integration

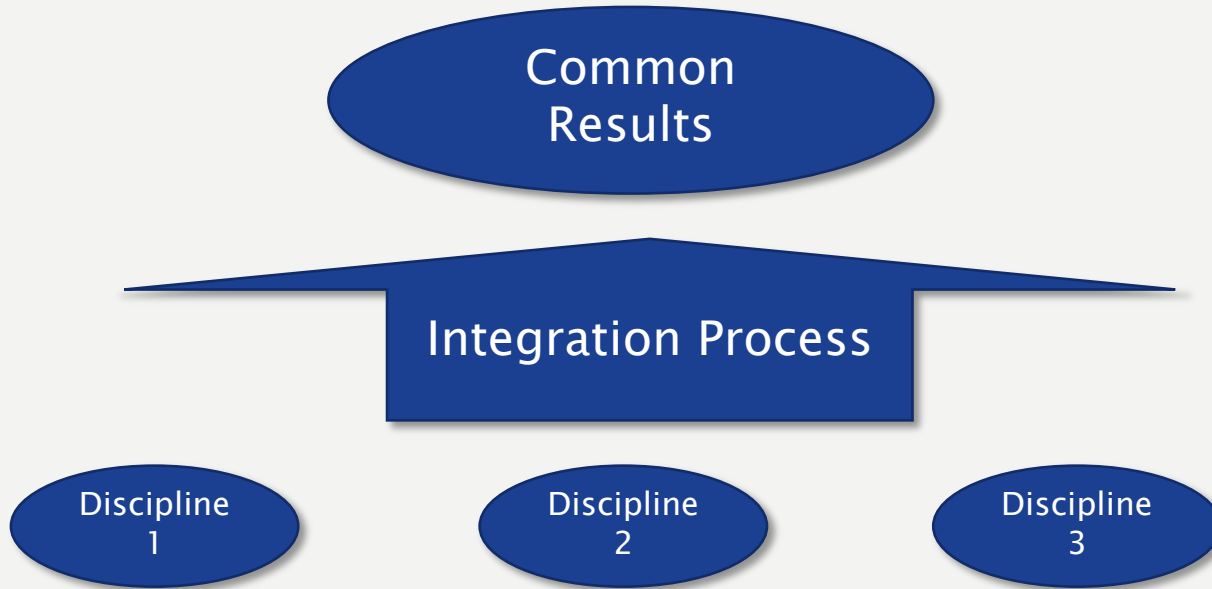

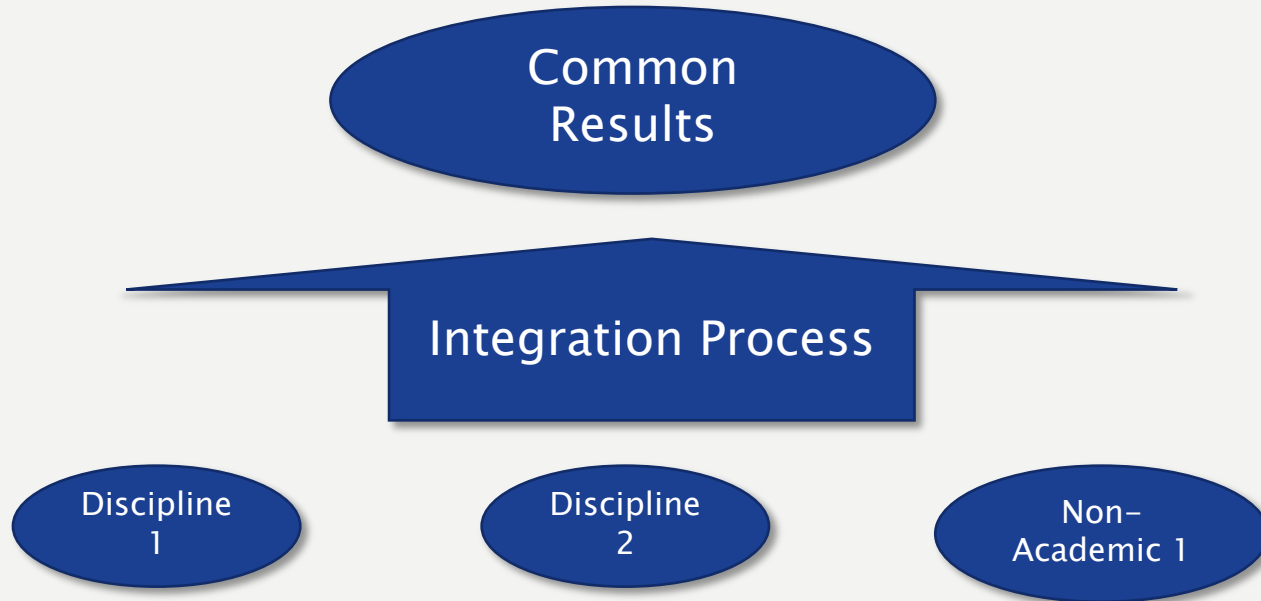

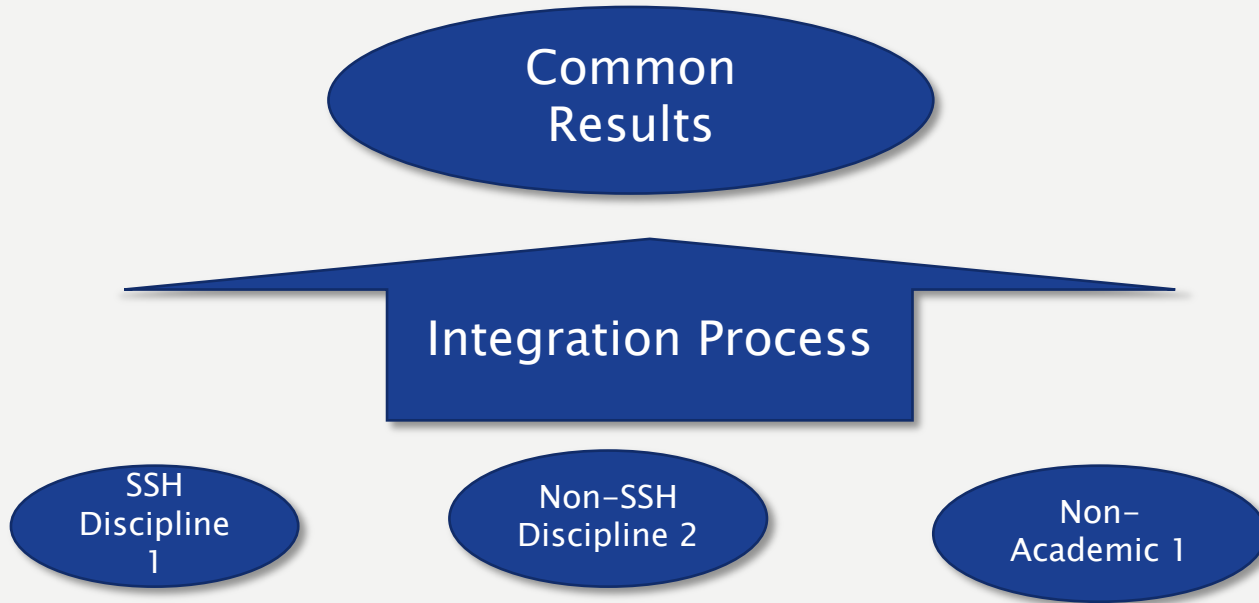
